

**Minutes of the Extra Ordinary Full Council Meeting**

**FC125 Apologies for Absence**

Apologies for absence were received from Cllr D Preece and Cllr G Preece (work commitments)

**RESOLVED:** To accept these apologies

There were no apologies received from Cllr TS

Cllr DJ informed the clerk via email on the evening of 27 October 2021 that she had not received the summons to attend (due to it being sent to an incorrect email address).

*Cllr MR addressed the councillors and explained that this meeting had been called because new information had been received which was not known at the time of the decision but may have affected the outcome, since an opinion was sought by the clerk at the Full Council meeting held on Thursday 21 October 2021.*

**FC126 Declarations of Interest**

There were no declarations of interest.

**FC127 Correspondence**

Supporting documents that had been received, together with a copy of the tenancy agreement and rules and photographic evidence of the condition of plot 19 were electronically distributed to all councillors prior to the meeting.

*Cllr MR, as chair of the meeting made the decision to allow two members of the public to speak. It had been acknowledged as being a contentious topic and he felt it was important to hear their version to, having received correspondence from the allotment holder who has been asked to vacate his plot. There is a written statement available to support these comments.*

**RESOLVED:** Proposed by Cllr MR, seconded by Cllr GF, to allow the members of the public to speak. All in favour.

Cllr MR read out the following statement.

PUBLIC BODIES (ADMISSION TO MEETINGS) ACT 1960 PRIOR TO THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE NEXT BUSINESS, THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS PROPOSED, SECONDED AND CARRIED: "That in view of the confidential nature of the business about to be transacted, it is advisable in the public interest that the press and public be temporarily excluded, and they are instructed to withdraw"

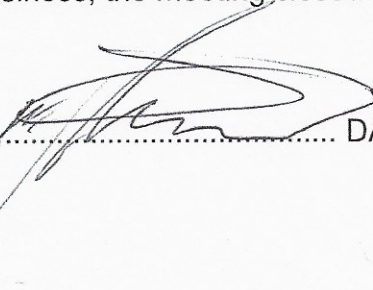
He thanked the two members of the public for attending and they left the meeting.
