Tuxford Town Council Snow Clearing Policy

(reviewed October 2018)

Clear snow from a road, path or cycleway

When you clear snow and ice:

- do it early in the day - it's easier to move fresh, loose snow
- don't use water - it might refreeze and turn to black ice
- use salt if possible - it will melt the ice or snow and stop it from refreezing overnight (but don't use the salt from salting bins as this is used to keep roads clear)
- you can use ash and sand if you don't have enough salt - it will provide grip underfoot
- pay extra attention when clearing steps and steep pathways - using more salt may help
- take care that cleared snow does not block other paths or drains

Tuxford Town Council has agreed to give priority to The Beeches, Birch Court and The Pastures, where residents are not able to clear snow for themselves.

In addition, the following areas will be cleared where possible

- Public car park, Newark Road
- At least one side of Newark Road, Newcastle Street and the Market Place to allow clear passage to the school, shops and the Post Office
- Path/driveway to Council office and Library, Lincoln Road
- Village Hall Steps and footpath across Village Hall field to Ashvale Road
